Age of Entrance

A student may enter kindergarten if his/her chronological age will be five before September 30 of the year entering school. No exceptions shall be made for early entrance to kindergarten.

A student may enter grade one if his/her chronological age will be six before September 30 of the year of entering school.

A birth certificate must be presented upon registration as proof of the date of birth.

Acceptance of transfers from states with differing eligibility requirements shall be left to the discretion of the Principal.
